

Larger Than Life Texan Project

Today you will listen to each group member read his/her report on a famous Texan. Then as a group you will need to choose ONE of these Texans who will be your group's Larger Than Life Project.

For this project you will create a life-sized visual representation of your Texan. You will use a 6-foot long section of butcher paper and lie down on it to draw the outline of your person. Creatively decorate this huge figure to resemble your Texan. Also, be sure to include at least one object with your life-sized figure that symbolizes an important aspect of your Texan's life. Remember as you create you project to consider the achievements that make this person a "Larger Than Life Texan."

Procedures:

Criteria for Larger Than Life Texan:

1. The Texan should be a life-sized figure.
2. The figure should be decorated attractively and colorfully with care and neatness.
3. The figure should resemble the Texan in detail. (Make it look like the real person.)
4. At least one object should be included with your Texan that symbolizes an important aspect of his/her life.
5. The Texan's name should appear somewhere on the project.
